

- x Access needed information effectively and efficiently, evaluate information sources critically, use information effectively to accomplish a specific purpose, understand the economic, legal, and social issues surrounding the use of information and access and use information technically.
- x Professional attitudes including but not limited to: excellence, accountability, excellence, initiative, responsibility, service, honor, honesty, integrity, respect for others, compassion.
- x Full range of motion of body joints.
- x Execute controlled motor movements to provide direct care and emergency treatment to patients, e.g. transferring, lifting, turning patients and providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation.
- x Stand unassisted for eight (8) continuous hours.
- x Carry/lift instrument trays and patients weighing up to 50 pounds on a daily basis.
- x Maintain adequate skin integrity, without the presence of open, weeping lesions.
- x (sterilants, x-rays, fumes, latex).

- x Adapt effectively to changing environments.
- x Maintain composure when subjected to high stress levels.
- x Maintain consistent mental alertness for a period of up to eight (8) continuous hours.
- x Respond in an emotionally controlled manner in learning situations, especially those with high tension levels.
- x Maintain punctuality, positive work attitude and respect for others, professionalism and the ability to interact with persons of diverse backgrounds.
- x Practice with compassion and respect for the inherent dignity, worth, and uniqueness of every individual, without regard to social or economic status, personal attributes, or the nature of health problems.
- x No disqualifying conditions as listed on the Illinois Department of Public Health (IDPH) Disqualifying Condition list.
- x No positive drug screen or clearance by a Medical Review Officer.
